- “We just tried to be on the lead first and get a place in the final. If she was ok, she would go on, if not...that was it,” said trainer Nicolas Vandenplas when finally tracked down in the paddock as he was all alone on double duty as trainer/caretaker Friday night.
- “She didn’t do too much because she raced her on Monday, so we have just been jogging her everyday.”
- “I don’t think we will be making any changes heading into next weeks race. I sure hope not. I am happy with what she did this week, that’s for sure. I was not expecting to win, but we didn’t have to go to fast tonight. We only had to go in 1:54. Luc did a great job with the filly and I hope we are going to be lucky next week.”
- Nicolas Vandenplas, making his first Breeders Crown start as a trainer, has had Brigham Dream from the very beginning – she is a homebred- She has never ever been a problem. She has always been healthy, an easy keeper and she has lots of character.
- Nicolas started hanging around standardbreds at a young age. His sister, who worked for Ferme Canaco in Quebec, would take him with her, when babysitting. The young Nicolas was enthralled and has never wondered far. Nicolas has worked for Dream With Me Stable (Jean Pierre Dubois) for over 10 years, since getting his license.
- Driver Luc Ouellette also had high praise for Brigham Dream. “Mr. Dubois is in Kentucky right now, he has some affairs to take care of and he asked me if I'd drive her tonight. I'm not sure if he'll need my services next week, but it was certainly a pleasure to sit behind her tonight.”

- “We all know what this mare can do, she's a big strong mare but it seems at times she can be pretty difficult to drive. Mr. Dubois has done a great job with her. At times I've seen her run for a step or two and he'll get her back trotting. Needless to say, I drove her like I was holding eggs on my lap.”
- “I believe it was real good mentally for her because when I pulled her off a helmet again she went out of there like she was leaving the gate. I think mentally it did her a lot of good and she came to the wire well within herself. Goodness willing she'll be good next week.”
- “I don't think I even picked my whip up, I just showed it to her. She was just a trotting machine.”
- Brigham Dream showed her temper in the Matchmaker Stakes at the Meadowlands in July. She was trotting comfortably in third, then for no reason rolled into a wild gallop, and DuBois could not get her back on stride. She did not finish the race.
- Jean Pierre Dubois is not only a very talented horseman, he is a fine businessman, too, and several years ago he began to export frozen semen collected from his French stallions all over the world. One of the Dubois stallions, who have been marketed worldwide, is Ganymede, a grandson of Royal Prestige. Among the many talented Italian offspring of Ganymede is the 4-year-old Iglesias, named after the world renowned Spanish singer Julio Iglesias.
- DuBois's influence has been felt on both sides of the Atlantic. The DuBois father and son team drove both the winner and second place finisher in this year's Prix Phaeton and Prix Paul Leguery, two of the biggest races for 4-year-old trotters.
- To add to the Dubois success, both winners, Quaker Jet and Qualita Bourbon, as well as the second placed Quatre Juillet, were all sired by Love You -- who belongs to Jean Pierre Dubois.
- DuBois also bred the international champion Cocktail Jet, Dr Ronerail. Just Like Dream, Little Moon Lake and Taurus Dream. Dubois-trained starters include Duchess Lobell, Hamerikanoz and Saorse.
- It has been reported that Saturday night's start in the Breeders Crown will be Brigham Dream's last start with the Reveavecmoi Dream With Me Stable of Brigham, QC. The four-year-old trotting mare has been sold to Deo Volente Farm of New Jersey. Farm partner, Mike Gulotta says “with her bloodlines she's a broodmare that can be bred to so many different stallions”. They may decide to race her in the Allerge in Kentucky.
