## Quotes & Notes

- Though Double Dream N posted a disappointing seventh place finish in her 2008 Breeders Crown elimination at Mohawk, the New Zealand import still posted a 1:50.4 clocking for driver Ron Pierce. Conditioned by Darren McCall from his home base of Classy Lane Farm in Ontario, the hardy and sometimes cranky mare trained lightly mid-week in preparation for her 2008 Breeders Crown Mare Pace contest.
- "She came out of the race alright," McCall offered. "She was second in this event last year after winning her elimination, and the competition then wasn't as stiff at that time of year and she was really sharp then. We kind of have an opposite scenario this year in that her competition is really tough and she's not at her peak right now."
- The 7-year-old mare was imported into the United States from New Zealand in January 2007 for owners Redmark Enterprises, racing steadily since age 4. She captured her first start on American soil on Jan. 19, 2007 for driver Yannick Gingras at The Meadowlands, pacing in 1:52.4, and scored a mark of 1:49.2 on May 11, 2007 at The Big M. She won her 2007 Breeders Crown Mare Pace elimination over Darlin's Delight and Vysoke Tatry.

- “She can get a real attitude at times, and could get testy going to the gate,” McCall stressed. “When she was racing in New York with (trainer) Billy Parker earlier this summer she got turned out a lot and kind of got back into her groove, and so we’re trying to do the same thing with her now. We just try to keep her happy and not put her in a situation where she is stressed too much on a daily basis.”
- **Darren McCall** credits his father, who trained and performed chiropractic on horses, with teaching him a lot about harness racing. “He taught me more than just the basics. He taught me how to shoe a horse, clean their teeth – things like that. By the time I was 14, I was breaking the babies on the farm.”
- McCall was also the trainer of record on 2002 freshman filly trot winner Pick Me Up, and trains Double Dream N and Corleone Kosmos in the Mare Pace and Open Trot. Both were second in their Crown finals here last year.

- Redmak Enterprises is made up of Evan Katz, Rick Agid and Denise Motta. The three work together as public insurance adjusters that represent policyholders against insurance companies. The name “Redmak” comes from the first and last initials of each member.
- “We’re business associates as well as very good friends for about 15 years,” Katz said. “We wanted a good race mare for the Meadowlands and Yonkers, so we got more than we bargained for. Racing in the Breeders Crown is very exciting for us.”
- Katz, who grew up going to the races at Roosevelt, previously trained and drove horses, primarily at Monticello Raceway. Agid was a longtime fan who got into ownership through some clients. Agid owned the top pacers Nuclear Flash and Maximilion Hanover in the mid-1990s.
- Double Dream N is Motta’s first horse. “The two of them sucked me in,” she said, laughing. “I grew up going to the track, so it didn’t take too much arm twisting. They told me she was beating the boys in New Zealand and I thought that sounded like my kind of mare. Everyone keeps telling me this isn’t how it happens. I hope we keep up the luck just a little longer.”
