### Quotes & Notes

- Flash Lightning followed along in the Breeders Crown elim to finish 8th, trotting in 1:55.1. "Well, we just wanted to make the final. We knew that she would not be really tight," said trainer Sue Marie Gangell. "She has just come off a qualifier, so she needed a tightener, so with anything we would have been happy."
- "She just trained one trip three days out and- I've only had her for a week I did not get much time to do much with her. She will jog everyday and then she will train two trips leading into the final. She's a nice mare, she's nice and quiet. I was hoping that she would really jump up, but you have to be realistic, she just came off a qualifier and she is not race tight. I hope that she is on the inside, because I think that she can get away half decent."
- This is Sue Marie Gangell's first start in the Breeders Crown. Flash Lightning was under the care of Nat Varty for previous starts.
- Owner **Glenn Berger** (Lightening Stable) is optimistic "I truly think that Flash is as good as anybody in the field," he said. "I expect a big effort from her. She has had problems in the past with tying up and making breaks, from too small bikes, that's all been fixed now. She will be going back to Nat Varty on Tuesday, and he will decide where she will be going next - Maybe the Allerge."

- Kentuckiana Farms**, established in 1975 by Tom and Betty Crouch, is a family-owned and operated farm involving the Crouch's three daughters and their spouses. The main farm is located on 1,400 acres in Fayette and Scott counties in Kentucky, with other facilities in New Jersey and Indiana and supports more than 100 broodmares grazing its bluegrass fields, all rich in pedigree. Crouch, originally a commodities broker and livestock analyst, has been a pillar of support in the harness community, as a partner in the Kentucky Standardbred Sales Co., and the Lexington Select Sale Co., a founding member of the Classic Series, a patron and benefactor of the American Championship Harness Series, a stake sponsor, and a Hambletonian Society director. The farm's first Crown breeders credit came from Follow My Star, one of the greatest pacing fillies of all time and once the richest distaffers ever. That trophy multiplied quickly as Kentuckiana surged to a place among the leaders on the all-time Breeders Crown earnings list. Kentuckiana Farms General Partners) has had eight championships.
- It was announced this week, that Tom Crouch has inducted into the Harness Racing Living Hall of Fame, one of the sport's highest honors.
