### Quotes & Notes

- Go On BB finished eighth in her Breeders Crown elim, but this Indiana-bred invader may have needed the start, according to her U.S.-based conditioner, Ronnie Burke.
- “This mare takes about a week or so to get adjusted to new surroundings,” Burke explained. “So we’re hoping that she’ll be in better shape for the final.”
- Go On BB will be harnessed by Canadian-based trainer Richard Moreau, who conditions the Burke Stable’s horses when they race at Canadian ovals. To date she’s earned \$572,669 racing mainly at Midwestern raceways.
- “We purchased her at 2 for the Indiana Sires Stakes and you just can’t find a nicer horse to be around,” said Burke. “Basically she’s as close as you’re going to get to being a perfect horse. Richard said she came out of the elimination okay, and we’re just hoping she’ll fire this week since she’ll be a little more acclimated to her surroundings.”
- Baldachino was looking for a horse, and picked out Go On BB himself, Burke explained.
- “He’s always on the lookout for a nice horse, and we especially were looking for a nice mare that fit into the Indiana program,” Burke noted. “She’s absolutely the most perfect horse around in every way, and has matured into a nice racehorse on her own. She tries her heart out and has perfect manners.”

## Mare Pace

- **Frank Baldachino**, of Clarksburg, New Jersey, first became an owner in 1984 and has since owned over 100 horses. He currently owns a stable of 30 and is the breeder of eight Standardbreds. He has had a pair of previous Breeders Crown starters: L Dee's Val carried his colors in 2005, in the \$331,500 Breeders Crown Mare pace, finishing fourth to Loyal Opposition for driver John Campbell in 1:51.3; and Paradise Justine, who finished second in the 2002 Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Trot to Pick Me Up in 1:58.3 with James Marshall driving. He is also the breeder of Hana Hanover, another starter in the 2008 Breeders Crown Mare Pace.

- **Richard Moreau**, 43, is a native of LaChenaie, Quebec and has trained 2,772 winners to over \$17,3 million in his career. He posted his best season in 2007, conditioning 335 winners to \$2,766,638 in seasonal earnings. This is his first Breeders Crown starter.
- **Robert Bendel**, 71, of Lebanon, Ohio has owned, trained and bred Standardbreds nearly all of his life. This is his first Breeders Crown starter.
