- Green Day did not turn in an impressive performance in the track record Breeders Crown elim, fading to eighth. He was placed seventh when another contestant broke.
- “He’s got to be better next week, said trainer Jim Raymer. “ I think he will be, he was sick his last start and did not get to race. And it hurt him missing that week. And then having to move first up at the 3/4 pole -- the way the race went, we did not have any other choice. This week we are going to train and jog him to get him a little tighter. He is going to have to be better.
- For a \$6,000 yearling purchase, Green Day returned huge dividends at three, despite not being eligible to a lot of the major stakes. He banked more than \$700,000 for the Raymer family with 12 wins, including the Nevele Pride, Galt, Yonkers Trot and was third in the Ky Futurity. Green Day, named for the popular rock band, did not fare so well at age four.
- “It’s so hard for some of the 3-year-olds when they come back the next year,” said Raymer. “You don’t see it as often because most of the top 3-year-olds go to stud, but those that do come back are really at the bottom, because they have to race against aged horses. He will be a better horse next year when he has that extra time to mature. But he is still Green Day. He comes out every day and goes to work. He just hates getting beat. That’s all and if they ever moved this to a ½ mile track we would win! – You can quote me on that.”
- Jim Raymer, 55, is a native of Markham, Ontario, and now lives in New Holland, Pennsylvania. Trillium Racing Stable is Mary Elizabeth, Jim’s wife.
