### Quotes & Notes

- Southwind Madonna proved she's the one to beat in the Breeders Crown Mare Pace after posting a 1:49.3 clocking, a new lifetime record, in her elimination at Mohawk on Aug. 23. The daughter of Camluck romped to victory for driver Lyle MacArthur, son of trainer and co-owner Carl MacArthur, who supplemented the 5-year-old mare for \$37,500.
- "I bought her as a 3-year-old. A fellow from the Meadows sent her up here for me to train and mentioned that she was also for sale if I liked her," said MacArthur. "Well the minute I laid eyes on her I loved her. She had a great head, bright eye and her ears-just the way she held herself. She did not disappoint. She is as good-tempered mare as there is. I compare her to my wife and that is a compliment to both of them. I always tell my wife – it's a toss-up between the two of you who has the better temperament and that's a compliment to you both."
- The locale of the race also played into MacArthur's decision to supplement. "Absolutely the race being here influenced my decision. If it was at The Meadowlands that would be a different story. Here its close and I just don't truck all over the country," said MacArthur. "I figured she deserved to have a shot in here. She got beat a head in the Roses Are Red and won last week so we really only had to put up half as much. "She is just a sweetheart of a mare, not a dirty bone or sulky bone in her body. If you drew a picture of a perfect horse, it would be her."

- “She’s a very nice mare to drive, and doesn’t have any quirks,” said Lyle. “We’ve been happy with her all year and especially the other night. She’s one of the top mares around right now and any of them can go good trips at any time, but she’s at her peak right now.”
- Southwind Madonna has \$764,766 in her career bankroll. Unraced at 2, she has since stormed to 21 career victories from 93 starts for the elder MacArthur and the Talacadac Stables of Ontario. She will be the first Breeders Crown starter for this partnership. Talacadac Stable is made up of the MacArthur sons Darryl, Carl, Leigh and Lyle (who handles the driving) and their good friend Tony Bonos.
- Bonos owns a restaurant named Charteuse, not far from Woodbine Racetrack and the MacArthur farm. The restaurant features French Continental cuisine and is named for the naturally green liqueur.
- Bonos has owned horses for more than 30 years and has been with the MacArthur stable for the last 15. Southwind Madonna, he says, is by far the best horse he’s owned in that time.
- “She has surpassed all our expectations and has been such a good mare for us.” said Bonos. “She deserves a chance to prove it. Even last year when she won the Grassroots final we knew what she was. Then she was second in the Roses Are Red to Tidewater Dragonfly. She belongs with these horses.”
- “Dad will jog her and train her up a little bit, as she’s not one that needs a lot of time off before races,” Lyle explained. “When she’s good, she’s better off to race. Dad would train her a little stiffer if she had a week in between starts. She’s very durable mare and really thrives on racing week in and week out.”
- Southwind Farm has had 24 Breeders Crown starters over the years, including two champions, Mystical Maddy and Southwind Serena. Other starters include 2007 Meadowlands Pace and Art Rooney winner Southwind Lynx and Dan Patch divisional champion Southwind Tempo, as well as 2006 Pacer of the Year Total Truth.

- Camluck highlighted his racing career by winning the 1991 Breeders Crown Horse Pace at The Meadows at four and was voted the O'Brien Award Older Pacing Horse of the Year. He retired with 26 wins, a time-trial record of 1:48.4, and lifetime earnings of \$1,003,260.
- Camluck then went on to be one of harness racing’s most prolific and successful sires. He was inducted into the Canadian Hall of Fame in 2003 and the hallowed U.S. Hall in July of this year. His progeny amassed \$15,486,801 in 2006, making him the richest single-season pacing sire of all time. He sire 1,335 starters with 448 in 1:55 and 29 in 1:50. Their earnings total over \$133 million with 369 \$100,000 earners.
- In the Breeders Crown, Camluck offspring have won more than \$1.5 million and three trophies, all in the distaff category, with two in this division: Burning Point, winner of the 2003 and 2006 Breeders Crown and Molly Can Do It, Mare Pace winner of 2002.
- There have been 15 supplements to the division, the most of any in the Crown series. One supplement, Ron’s Girl, in 2000, won this event, though most of the supplements have finished in the black.
