Quotes & Notes

Tigerama, making his first start since July 19, raced in the open at Mohawk last week and finished fifth after leading for much of the mile. Jody Jamieson was the driver.

“He threw a shoe, so he should hopefully be better [this] week,” trainer Casie Coleman. “Jody just finished telling me that he thought that he should have jogged at the head of the lane. Then he started getting a bit steppy and then he stepped off his right front shoe. We will get that fixed up and we’ve got the rail [in the Breeders Crown].”

“He needed a start, so hopefully we will be better.”

Tigerama paced the fastest mile in the 37-year history of Western Fair Raceway when he won a Molson Pace elimination race in 1:50.4 in May.

Owner Bob Hamather, 70, has owned and bred more than 150 horses in his career. His most notable horse was 1993 Breeders Crown Open Pace winner Staying Together.

Trainer Casie Coleman, 28, is on the verge of seeing her stable top \$3 million for a third consecutive year. She was the O'Brien Award winner as Canada's top trainer in 2005 and 2006. She was a finalist for the honor last year, but saw it go to Blair Burgess.

Coleman won a Breeders Crown with Moving Pictures in the 2007 Mare Pace at Mohawk. Moving Pictures was named the top pacing mare in both Canada and U.S. last season.

In 2004, Coleman won more than 100 races and \$1 million in purses to become the youngest female trainer in Canada to reach those milestones.

A native of British Columbia, Coleman re-located to Ontario a few years ago when her parents, Linda and Phil, moved their stable to the Flamboro Downs area. Coleman drove for the family before starting her own stable and concentrating on training.

Both Coleman and her father, Phil, have an entrant in the Crown events. Dad starts Illusionist in the Mare Pace, an event won by his daughter last year with the mare Moving Pictures. They could strike a unique double should they both win their events

The sire of Tigerama, Village Jiffy, has two Breeders Crown victories. He won this event in 1994 at Freehold Raceway over the heavy favorite Riyadh. He also won as a 2-year-old at Pompano, upsetting Life Sign. Tigerama is his first starter in the Crown series.

Should Tigerama win, he would tie Fool's Goal as the oldest winning Crown contestant at 8-years-old. There have been five 5-year-old winners of the Crown Open Pace, and Eternal Camnation is the oldest mare to win that event, at six.
