- Vulcanize flashed some late trot to finish third in the Crown elim behind Brigham Dream and Bruschette. "She's a nice mare," said driver Steve Condren. "I'd like a post position somewhere in the middle and then a good trip in the final. If she gets a good trip she will get money. It doesn't get any simpler than that."
- Trainer Bob McIntosh was fine with the elim effort. ""She would have raced better if she did not have road trouble. She had to go three-wide up the backstretch. She is coming into next week's race, real good."
- McIntosh is the leading money-winning and trophy trainer in the 25-year Breeders Crown series. He is a member of the U.S. Hall of Fame and has been voted trainer of the year honors numerous times on both sides of the border.
- McIntosh won this division, just once, with the upsetter Armbro Affair in 2004.

- **Lothlorien Equestrian Centre** located in Mississauga, ON, was owned and operated by Audrey Campbell, who passed away in 2007. The stable carries on in her memory under daughters' tutelage.
- The late Audrey Campbell had owned Standardbreds for more than two decades. She was the daughter of late millionaire Roy Thomson, who owned more than 200 newspapers in Canada and the U.S., and the sister of entrepreneur Ken Thomson. Her daughters, Susan and Gail, are well known in the riding world and provide horses to many of Canada's top show jumping riders. Lothlorien Equestrian Centre is an extensive race and riding horse breeding facility that includes the old Armstrong Brothers farm.
- Campbell teamed with Jeff Snyder on ownership of 2005 Horse of the Year Rockroll Hanover. His victories included the Meadowlands Pace, North America Cup and Breeders Crown. He earned \$2.23 million for the season, the third-highest earnings in history behind Gallo Blue Chip in 2000 and Cam's Card Shark in 1994. Campbell and Snyder first became partners after bidding against each other on Red River Hanover at the Harrisburg yearling sale in 2000. They decided to work together and Red River Hanover went on to capture the 2002 North America Cup for them.
- In addition, the late Mrs. Campbell and her late husband, Ellwood, owned Armbro Dallas, who won \$1.4 million lifetime and was one of the few horses to ever beat Nihilator.
