**2 STONEBRIDGE GALAXY** gets top billing in the opener. The first two races on the program include the "meat and potatoes" pacers. The overnight types that every track needs to keep going. It's always nice to see the stakes performers but I always like to recognize the importance of those that race on a weekly basis on the local scene. Zeron has others racing later that he trains. I'm just about convinced that at least one will take a victory. Hopefully it is this pacer to get you off to a quick start.

**4 RINESTONE PHANTOM** is back to a more suitable level of competition after a series of three races against higher level rivals. I've mentioned in a later race that MacDonell could have a very successful night at the office. This pacer could get him win number one with others very possible as the night goes on. I had to rate him as one of the main contenders with class dropping profile.

**3 GIBRALTAR HANOVER** looks to be a playable option to the pair that I've rated highest in the order. He scored in late May in a higher classification. MacDonell did give the nod to the one above when he had to choose. I considered that factor but wouldn't write this pacer off as a "no play" because of that. A pick 3 wager might be considered to start the evening. He'll be on the ticket if I do invest.

**10 DURHAMS CAM** tried the early speed approach last week. He lasted for a long time but then gave way near the end to settle for the finish in the show position. If he can handle that tough race and come back with another similar performance, he might overcome the post 10 handicap well enough to put another on the board finish on his resume. The outside post should improve the price that is offered.

**THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER (NOT RANKED)**

- (1) KING JOE** was a minor player in his last start on this circuit. He looks like he might have to settle for similar results tonight.
- (5) FAUST BLUE CHIP** hasn't won a race this year. Not too many that Fellows trains has a goose egg in the win column. I won't predict that his losing streak will halt this night.
- (6) MASTER THE ART** competed in claimers in December, 2007 at Woodbine with a \$22,000 price tag. Results at that time were very poor. Woodstock preps with good results have earned him another chance at the major league level. I'll let you decide about whether or not he should be considered for a higher rating.
- (7) ARMBROS REVENGE A** is one that I want to watch for another start or two before I consider again for a high in the order rating. The post position improvement should help but I'll pass.
- (8) THEMACHMAN PROPHECY** was borderline when it came time to choose between a top or bottom group prediction. He's not a complete write off but I preferred others.
- (9) PACIFIC PRINCE** didn't appeal very much from post position 9. I thought that handicap might be his downfall. If he comes back to try again and has better luck in the draw I might consider for an upset play at that time.

**2 SKY TANTRUM** ended up with Campbell driving when scratch time changes were available. Two starts back he produced speed in the 1:50 range but he doesn't do that every night. If he can duplicate that performance, then he will make the others earn what they get. Post 2 combines well with the early speed that he can produce when asked to race that way. I'll give him a slight preference.

**8 DEDALOS** didn't race so tough last time. That last one might set him up for a quick return to winning form. McMaster has had good recent results at this same level of competition with this four year old son of Artiscape. I gave him the favourite's role in the morning line. Post 8 might not be too much of a problem if not too many of the inside starters are in a quick start mode. Luc might end up with a two/three hole trip.

**6 MY MASTERPIECE** would be considered for a play if he has a good race night appearance. The second try at Mohawk produced better results when Waples took over the driving duties. He's back to try again for a very high percentage trainer. Numbers just below the .500 mark makes you sit up and take notice. Give him a once over inspection on Saturday night before finalizing the decision on his status.

**4 LEGACY N DIAMONDS** should appreciate the move out of stakes competition. This is an easier spot for him. I might be underestimating with the four slot rating. Last year he banked more than \$175,000 in his rookie campaign. He's still looking for his first purse cheque in 2008. This could be the night for the bankroll to be increased again. Post 4 shouldn't cause any problems.

**THE FOLLOWIGN LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER (NOT RANKED)**

**(1) LATENITE RUSTLER** might be in a tougher spot tonight than last time when he finished second best. I'm going to rate him as an upset player.

**(3) SHAWS CREEK MADDY** needs to show me more against rivals in this class before I can get very interested. Once he moved up into the Nw4 level his form went on a downswing.

**(5) WINDSUM CALLUM** has the 10 hole position to use as a reason to forgive his last race when he couldn't crack the top five. He might be much better tonight. Beware!

**(7) LOST BLISS** might handle the class rise better than I think he will. Fellows had him prepped for a top performance last time and Zeron did his part by working the winning trip.

**(9) BELIEVEINBRUISER** has one top three finish this year. He does change from stakes events to an overnight situation this night. You can make your own guess.

**(10) JOSHUA PARK** was a predictable and popular winner a week ago but now he steps back up into a tougher spot. He also has the post 10 position to beat.

**8 DON GIOVANNI** gives trainer Anders Wolden a chance to take more than one purse share in the Goodtimes Stakes. Brian Sears is going to take over the driving assignment tonight. That change didn't affect the rating that I had in mind. Two of these same rivals beat him last week. He might turn the tables on one of those to finish with a top three result. That's the way I'm going to predict it.

**1 CLERK MAGISTRATE** wasn't expected to do as well as he did in the qualifying round. The patient drive that Ritchie provided worked to perfection. He finished off faster than the others. If he has the same performance to offer again this night, he might surprise again. He'd be worth a look at the right odds in only for the second or third spot if you don't think he can beat them all.

**(2) DEFINE THE WORLD** had Waples driving a week ago. He's sticking with the McIntosh connection tonight to give MacDonell the chance to handle this John Bax trainee. **(4) B STRIKE THREE** can't really be written off as a top three prospect. The margin of defeat wasn't that much last week when Moon Dreamer and Define the world were slightly better.

**(5) GUIDA MUSCLE** looked most like an upset player than a top win contender when I did the first assessment on them all. A small share is the best that I can predict for him.

**(7) WILDCAT SHOES** will offer high odds again unless the change to Campbell makes a big difference in his level of support from the bettors.

**(9) O U GUS** had the poor luck to draw outside. That factor caused me to rate him in the bottom group as only an upset prospect.

**(10) SUPERFAST STUART** looked to be quite risky from post 10. He's not nearly as accomplished as most of the others right at this stage of the game.

**(11—AE1) DI MANGGIO** might be good enough to grab a share of the purse if he does get the chance to race and draws into a favourable starting position.

**9 STONEBRIDGE MAGNUM** was only slightly preferred when it came time to rate the top four that I picked out of this field. I thought this was a tricky race to predict. It might come down to which one has the best racing luck or the smartest driver. The Burlington result was good. Waples didn't get him unwound last week when the competition was tougher than it is tonight. I think we might see an improvement this time.

**1 LONESTAR LEGEND** was rated as the race favourite. He looked like he should be a major player in this contest that offers the also rans from last week's elimination rounds the chance to compete for \$100,000. Miller drove him on June 7. It looks like he might have given early notice that his choice tonight would be Trade Editor. That decision will make a difference to some handicappers in the assessment process. Miller might be right and I wrong when rating this pacer and Nbr 2.

**2 TRADE EDITOR** had some interference last time and he is the choice of driver Dave Miller in the consolation of the Pepsi North America Cup. Had he made the final of that event, he would have been a longshot item. In this spot he looks like a competitive type if you have a hunch that he might improve on the speed that he had a week ago. His trainer seems to have the knack of having them ready when the opportunity is best.

**10 FOUR STARZ MOXIE** doesn't look any better or any worse than the others in the field. Sears will need to find a way to overcome the outside position. He can do that if the opportunity is there. A quick start might be the plan and could work if not too many of the inside starters are using the same approach. I'd have to recommend that you consider him for use in the opening leg of the pick 4 wager.

### THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER (NOT RANKED)

**(3) SPACE WALK** is going to develop into a nice prospect but he might not be quite ready to beat this field tonight. Campbell takes over the driving duties tonight. That might help. He also has a post position improvement.

**(4) IDLE HOUR** has a .500 win average this year and was better than that in 2007 during his rookie campaign. The change in post position and competition are positive factors that need to be considered.

**(5) ON THE BRINK** was borderline when it came time to decide on a spot in the top or bottom group. I chose the latter but he might fool me.

**(6) UPFRONT HANNAHSBOY** has the potential to upset or at least finish higher than rated if he can combine a top level performance with some racing good fortune.

**(7) FRANKLUVSMEATBALS** has local teamster Jamieson as his partner tonight. I put him into the group of upset prospects in this tough to predict 4th race. His suck along speed last week is better than most in the field.

**(8) SHADOW PLAY** needs to get it turned around again if he's going to be an impact player. The most recent starts have not been very good.

**7 CHANCEY LADY** has a group of very talented rivals to beat tonight if she's going to produce the predicted victory. I'll shoot for an upset and call for her to eke out a narrow win over the next two on the list. She was so good last fall that she was favourite in the Breeders Crown final. She had beaten A and Gs Confusion in the qualifying leg but did fail when the big money was on the line to finish ahead of just one rival. MacDonald needs to be at his best to make it happen. Coleman will likely have this gal prepped for the best possible result.

**1 TUG RIVER PRINCESS** heads the list of 3 year old pacing fillies in both money won and speed this year with \$166,000 in earnings and a 1:51.1 speed mark. She undefeated in eight starts but there is one mare that has nine wins. She wasn't lacking anything last week even with the layoff. The competition tonight is tougher with the one below and the one above in the mix and some others. She's my runner-up selection.

**2 A AND GS CONFUSION** had an important driver change to consider when she raced last week. The 2008 debut at Vernon was a workout with company. The .65 cent price would have been too low for my liking with the trainer driving and knowing that bigger things were upcoming. She led all 2 year old fillies in money won last year when she finished worse than second just once in 10 starts. Campbell drove her many times during the rookie campaign. Tonight he's trying to beat her with the one above.

**5 UP FRONT BETHANN** should be given a look for use in either the triactor or superfecta wager. She lucked out with a good draw to post 5. That won't hurt her chances. It would be an upset if she did beat them all but a top three/four results wouldn't surprise very much. A six win rookie campaign helped her to earn more than \$320,000 dollars. She should have some live cover to follow tonight. That change in racing style might help if it shows up.

**5 ESCAPABLE BEAUX** has been a fringe player recently and not able to beat them all on a given night. I'm going to take the gamble that he might improve enough to post the upset score in this week's edition of the WEG open pace. We should get fair wagering value if you want to play along. Others in the field look to be more logical and will attract more support from the bettors. Using him in the number one slot is as much of a hunch play as anything else.

**1 EAGLE LUCK** might step up tonight to improve on the third place finish from last week when Silent Swing and Western Shore were slightly better. He was only beaten one and one half lengths. He produced a major upset in the previous start when he was the upsetter in the Molson Pace at Western Fair Raceway. That \$140,000 pay day gave him most of his earnings for the year. He might add some more to the account tonight.

**2 WESTERN SHORE** was beaten by a fired up Silent Swing last week. The winner is resting but this pacer comes back to do battle again. That tough beat last time might have taken enough out of him that he might not be as good as expected in this spot. To use a thoroughbred handicapping term, he might bounce. That's a guess that you have to make. I'll likely consider leaving him off some exactor or triactor tickets if I do invest that way.

**9 SECRETS NEPHEW** has been on the shelf since May 17. I can't remember the last time that he was scratched from a scheduled start. He was reported sick on May 31. I don't want to underestimate his chances completely. Cagey driver/trainer Lyle MacArthur just might have a surprise planned tonight if all is well with his charge. I thought he deserved to be given a spot in the top four.

**THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER (NOT RANKED)**

**(3) ZOOKA** moved to Georgian to contest the Ontario Master Series for the O.S.S. graduates. He struggled there and wasn't able to keep up to the leaders well enough to make any major impact. That was just four days ago. He's better than that last one if at his best.

**(4) JUSTICE CAM** might be a step or two behind the best in this field if they all have equal chances to show their best performances. I thought he looked like an upset prospect. My top selection also falls into that category. Let's see if Hudon can get a bigger share than what I am predicting.

**(6) WINDSUN BEN** made a quick rise up the class ladder. Prior to March 29 his form was so poor that he was eligible to race in a nw600016 classification. That's when he started to get it turned around. He's now right at the top of the competition scheme with a three race win record on the line. Can he get 4?

**(7) LITTLE AMOS** is showing us once again why he's such a tough to predict pacer. On one of his best night's he can race very competitively against our best local pacers. You make the call.

**(8) I ZEE** steps up into a tougher spot tonight after a last start win over lower rated rivals. I'll be surprised if he takes the upset but anything can happen in a horse race.

**7 ART OFFICIAL** has this handicapper sitting on an 0-2 count. Using him in the top spot again tonight might give me strike three. For him or any of the others to beat **Somebeachsomewhere** it is going to take some help from one or more of the competition. I don't really think anyone is good enough to knock off the favourite on their own. There is always the chance of poor racing luck. It does happen in the big money races when the competitive factor is so high. If young teamster, **Tyler Buter**, can find a way to have him in the right spot soon enough, he should be making some impact in the stretch drive.

**2 SOMEBEACHSOMEWHERE** has never lost. He's never been seriously tested by a rival pacer in any of the races that I have been able to watch or view later via replay. The perfect record might still be intact when this race is over and done and he might still be waiting for a test of his speed and stamina. None are unbeatable however. I won't guess about **MacDonell's** strategy. He'll do the right thing at the right time to produce the best possible results. The other drivers will be in the same category but maybe not with as much horsepower to work with. He's strictly the one to beat.

**4 BADLANDS NITRO** has been racing very well. He has a near perfect record with just two losses in 12 previous races. The trainer/driver team is top of the line. We have three of four of the necessary ingredients for a winning recipe. If the fourth (racing luck) helps out the upset could go to him. He's looked strong in all the recent starts. He'll likely be the second most favoured starter in the field in the minds of the bettors. He can make things very interesting again.

**8 DALI** is a good enough colt to pull it off if the favourite is to be beaten. All the good things will have to be working. **Marfisi** needs to have him at his very best. **Luc** hopefully feels confident about choosing the racing style to use. He's the one sitting there making the split second decisions that can make the difference between doing well and not succeeding. I think he's going to be the top selection of broadcast analyst/handicapper **Mike Hamilton**. I guess I won't be the only one using the beat the favourite strategy.

#### THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER (NOT RANKED)

**(1) SANTANNA BLUE CHIP** has had only two starts. He has a reason to get better after each race. He didn't look to have the fire last time. Something has to change for the better if he's going to be a 1-2-3 finisher with all the 10 best competing.

**(3) DEUCE SEELSTER** had a bridle change for his last start. That move paid off to get him his first win of the year. He had a very solid rookie campaign and has not been worse than second this term. He still rates as an upset prospect tonight.

**(11—AE1) UPFRONT HANNAHSBOY** will have longshot status if he gets a chance to race. He'll compete in the consolation in race four if one of the original 10 is not withdrawn soon enough.

**5 BLISSED OUT** should offer a fair return on investment if you want to play along with a hunch that I have. This pacer isn't as good as he once was (lifetime record of 1:48.4) but might still be able to win at this level on the local scene if he combines a top performance with some racing good fortune. The superfecta wager can often produce a jackpot type payoff. This might be a spot where we see that type of result.

**9 BUCKEY ONE** is another pacer that has lots of back class. He's the fastest in the field with a 1:48.1 career best but not nearly that good now. I keep thinking that he's going to pop up with a winning performance any time now. There is class relief coming if the results continue to be mediocre. Should we wait for that to happen or try again tonight? This is his forth start since the comeback started. His conditioning should be at the top right now.

**10 OUR LUCKY KILLEAN** fits into the same mold as the two above in that he's seen better days and not racing so well right at this point in time in some races. The post position was not a big factor when I assessed his chances at finishing in the top three. He can race from mid pack or farther back. He's probably as good that way over the big track as he would be with a different strategy.

**8 CAMIFICATIONS** is overdue to win again. He's been a long time since his last victory. That was recorded on January 26 in the final of the Willowdale Series. He's raced in some tough spots since then including three tries in the Spring Pacing Championship Series against the best pacers on the local scene at the time. Maybe the change to Jamieson can wake him up.

**THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER (NOT RANKED)**

**(1) IRISH ELITIST** was not able to win when racing in a lower level than this. I had to predict just a small purse for him in this situation.

**(2) IMPECCABLE** has two positive changes tonight when compared to his last race. The post position is improved and he is dropping down to race at a lower level in the competition scheme. Maybe?

**(3) BUTTON UP** had a late fade after doing some middle half work on June 7. He also is dropping down the class ladder into what might be a better spot for him.

**(6) WESTCOAST MAN** has eight top three finishes this year but only one win from 14 starts. He's classified well enough to finish higher than rated if Waples can make the trip work to his advantage.

**(7) OUTRIGHT** might be better than I'm giving him credit for. The move to this circuit is interesting, especially with Tetric named to drive.

She's an upset prospect that I could consider easy enough if I like the price that is offered.

**2 WARRAWEE JUNE** won a flip of the coin type decision when it was time to choose the final top four option. She has been racing well even with poor starting positions in her profile. The post 2 situation tonight can only help her chances. Zeron didn't take any chances in the qualifying round when he took her to the lead early. This might be a tough race to come up with the winning triactor combination without playing more than one or two tickets. Paul will drive either Southwind Swallow or Arts Diva. The chance of a make amends win is there to consider. Some that played last week will be back for another try with an eye to recovering losses from June 7.

ORC PYLON RULE 18:08

When dealing with violations of standardbred rule 18.08 the following guidelines are to be used:  
1. Any horse or part of the horse's sulky that leaves the race course by going inside the pylons, when not forced to do so as a result of the actions of another driver and/or horse or without being interfered with by another driver and/or horse, shall be placed as follows:  
a) if any horse or part of the horse's sulky goes inside two (2) consecutive pylons, the offending horse shall be placed behind all horses that are lapped on to the offending horse at the wire;



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**RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS  
AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS**

**GENERAL**

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system.

Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

**ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS**

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system.

Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

**DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)**

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has been declared official, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool.

**EXACTOR/TRIACOR/SUPERFECTA**

An Exactor, Triactor, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exactor wager, the Exactor payout will be on first and third.

**PICK 3, PICK 4 AND PICK 7 BETTING**

The Pick 3, Pick 4 and Pick 7 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three, four or seven successive races specified for the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 7 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3, Pick 4 and a mandatory payout of the Pick 7 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, C) most second place finishers, or D) sequentially thereafter.

Where no tickets have been sold coupling the official winners of every leg of the Pick 7 and a mandatory pay-out does not apply, 20% of the day's net pool is paid out as described above while 80% is accumulated and carried over.

**PICK 3, PICK 4 AND PICK 7 SCRATCHES**

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 7 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 7, the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 7 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

**REFUNDS**

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start.

The Double, Pick 3, Pick 4 and Pick 7 pools are not refunded after the first leg has been declared official. Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

**COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)**

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race.

**FAIR START**

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

**LOST & OLD TICKETS**

WEG issued tickets or vouchers cannot be cashed at a teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at an Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

**ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY**

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licenced sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

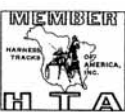

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except triactor wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, photo-finish, video patrol and audit services.



Pari-mutuel wagering, photo finish, video patrol and drug control services are provided under the supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, an agency of Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, the Honourable Gerry Ritz, Minister. All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the Pari-Mutuel Betting Regulations.
